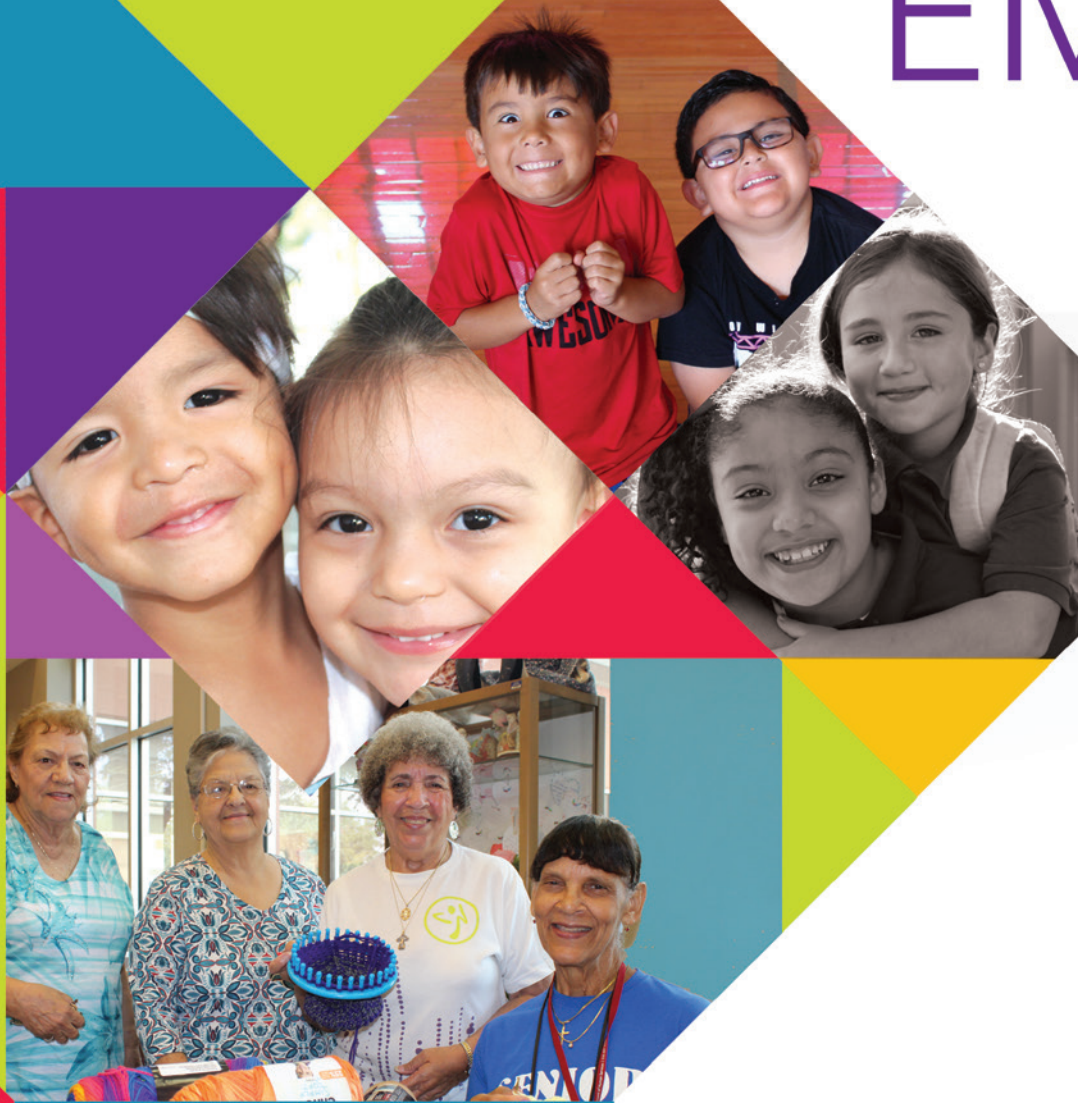

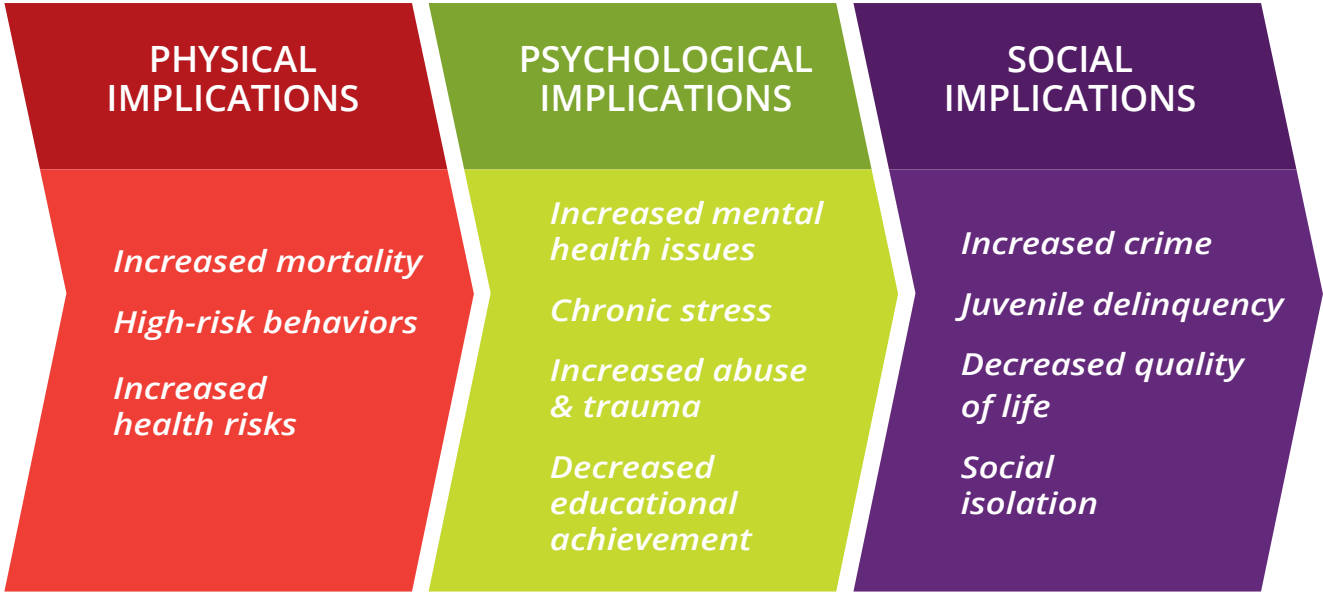

SPOTLIGHTS FROM THE YEAR

WE LAUNCHED A PARENTS AS TEACHERS (PAT) PROGRAM within the Child Development Services department. This evidence-based home visiting model is designed to engage parents and caregivers of children ages 0 to 5 to promote optimal early development, learning, and the health of children.

WE RECEIVED RECOGNITION BY THE STATE FOR THE FIFTH CONSECUTIVE YEAR. One or more students or staff members from Good Sam has received an award from the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services at the annual Partners in Prevention (PIP) Conference. The PIP Conference is the largest annual gathering of prevention and early intervention professionals in Texas, where parent educators, youth service providers, civic leaders, policy advocates, and researchers have the opportunity to learn and network as professionals. Since 2014, Good Sam has been a recipient of one or more of five awards presented each year at the conference.

OUR CAMPUS WAS VISITED BY COMMISSIONER JERRY MILNER. In August this year we were visited by Commissioner Jerry Milner, the Associate Commissioner at the Children's Bureau and the Acting Commissioner for the Federal Administration on Children, Youth, and Families. Commissioner Milner visited the campus to learn more about our service to the community and witness first-hand the impact of our programs. The highlight of the visit was a conversation between Commissioner Milner and several of our Youth Advisory Committee (YAC) members, where our students shared their experiences and challenges they face, and stories of the transformative relationships they've developed through Good Sam. The conversation was so rich, emotional, and honest that Commissioner Milner personally invited our youth to participate in his opening keynote address at the Annual Childcare Administrators Conference in Austin, Texas.

“I first started bringing my first daughter, Nyssa, to the Preschool program when she was three years old. We chose Good Sam because we fell in love with everything that Good Sam has to offer and we really like the environment. When my second daughter, Talia, was born, we enrolled her in the Early Head Start program as an eight-week-old.

I can definitely tell the difference between the girls, because Talia started as an infant and Nyssa started when she was almost three years old. They are both naturally smart, but Talia had language and focus at an earlier age than Nyssa. The routine really helped her growth, and I know she will be ready for school when she goes to kindergarten.

For the last year, we have participated in the Parents as Teachers program where Ms. Janie comes to our home for visits once per month. I like the home visits because she involves the whole family and there is always something that I learn about parenting. Janie gives me short lessons that I can look at online, which is great, because I don’t always have time to read.

I am proud of the way I have grown as a parent from my first child to my second. I understand things a little better and act intentionally, instead of reacting to situations in the moment. Good Sam has definitely taught me that and I am so thankful for the enrichment that Good Sam provides to me and my family.”

“I joined the Asset Building for Clients program in Brownsville my Senior year of High School, where I served on the Youth Advisory Committee (YAC). At the age of 18, I am considered a Junior at the University of Texas Rio Grande Valley and work as a Youth Service Specialist for Good Sam. The biggest challenge that I faced as a child was my education and the lack of technology that I had access to as a student.

Because of that, my spark has always been anything revolving around technology, but my future goals have changed since I've joined Good Sam. As a staff member for Camp Good Sam, I got to work with a student that expressed an interest in video game programming. The spark that I helped ignite in that student's mind was the beginning of a fire inside me to help others find their spark, and I thank him for that.

One of my main dreams now is to create a technology camp in my community where children can choose whichever technology career path and have the tools and teachers to develop their skills.

Growing up, I faced many challenges, both internal and external, that have shaped me into the individual I am today. I am proud that Good Sam has taught me that if I ever hit rock bottom, I have the courage to get back up, and that's the greatest accomplishment of my life.”

"I am in 6th grade at KIPP Camino Academy. My mom used to work at Good Sam before I was born, and she even got her GED here. I've been coming to the Afterschool and summer Camp Good Sam program since I was in first grade. I've been to Camp Capers twice! My mom and I always talk about if she won the lottery, we'll give so much back to Good Sam because we love it so much. Everyday, my brother and I ask her to pick us up later so we can stay.

I hate reading, it's a fact about me. One summer I could not come to Camp Good Sam because I didn't pass the STAAR reading test, and I had to go to summer school. That summer was so boring.

But at Camp Good Sam, we always read a book, and I realized that when I find something really interesting, I go ahead and take advantage and read it. I loved Percy Jackson, Five Kingdoms, and then I got really interested in The Land of Stories. I'm on the second book now!

I am writing a book now, but I'm barely on chapter three. One day I was reading The Land of Stories and all of a sudden I just started writing about these two people and I started illustrating it and drawing out what they look like. And then I finished the first chapter, and then chapter two, and chapter three! I'm thinking about becoming a writer when I grow up."

FAMILY DEVELOPMENT SERVICES

The goal of FDS is to develop life skills essential for family stabilization, self-sufficiency, and enhanced quality of life by providing a multi-faceted approach that consolidates and applies all available community resources.

SENIOR CENTER
160 seniors served

71% of clients demonstrated an increased quality of life, as measured by the Quality of Life Indicator within 90 days of enrollment

ADULT CASE MANAGEMENT
102 adults served

97% of clients developed the life skills and supports essential to family strengthening and stabilization and increased self-sufficiency after 90 days in case management services

100% of families in situational crisis acquired the assistance and support necessary for immediate problem resolution



RAUL

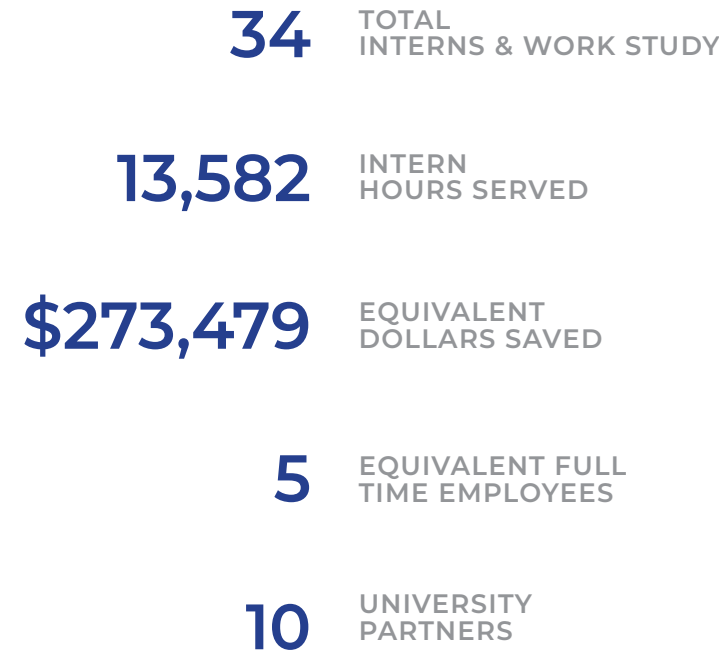
“I was born and raised here in San Antonio, but went to California in 1959 for 40 years. When my wife passed away, I felt like I should come back to where I was born and raised. Once I started coming to Good Sam, I began to volunteer in the kitchen. I make the coffee, set up lunch, and take out the lunch for those that are not able.

I then ran and became the President of the Senior Council for Good Samaritan. Our priority as officers is taking care of the other Seniors. I love what I’m doing because I like to help the Seniors, especially the ones who are disabled. It’s a good environment and a fun place to come. You get to meet people your own age or a little bit older, and everyone is nice, so it is good for the new Seniors who are coming in. I also teach the jewelry classes, I believe it helps with their hand-eye coordination. The idea is to get them to participate, because once they do, they love it, and continue to participate.

What I’ve been most proud of since coming to Good Sam is finding myself. After my wife passed I was staying home all the time. Once I started to come, and the people were so nice, it motivated me to get out. It’s a good environment and a fun place to be. Instead of staying home and doing nothing, we get to come here and meet new people.”

FIELD EDUCATION SERVICES

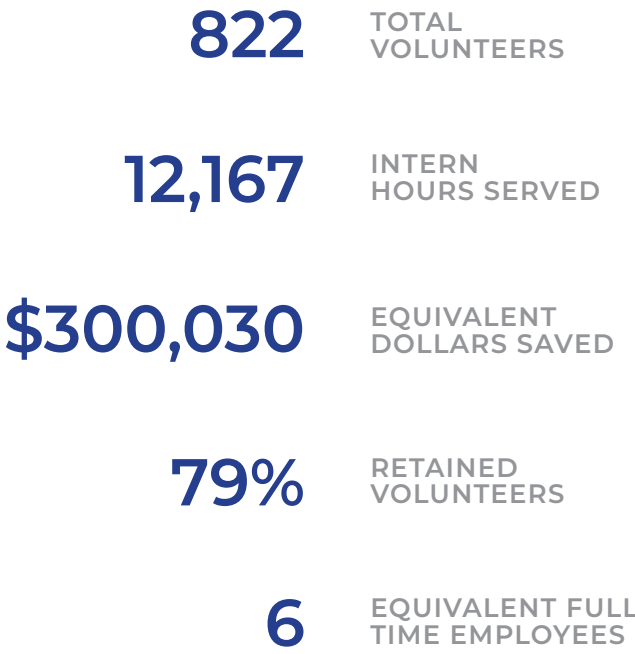
The Field Education program leverages partnerships with higher education partners to provide collegiate-level students with opportunities to gain relevant, professional experience in a collaborative environment.

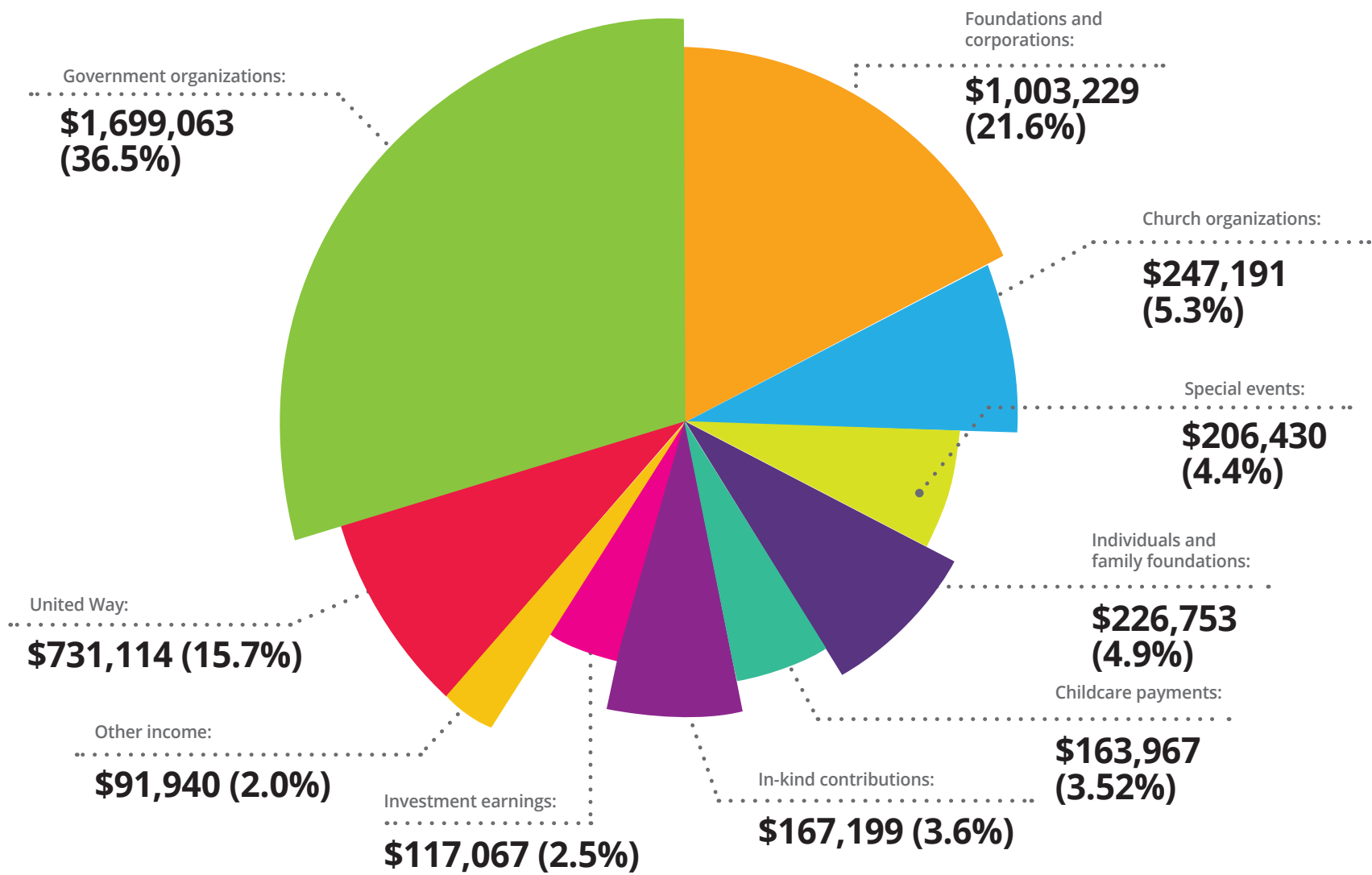

REVENUES BY SOURCE

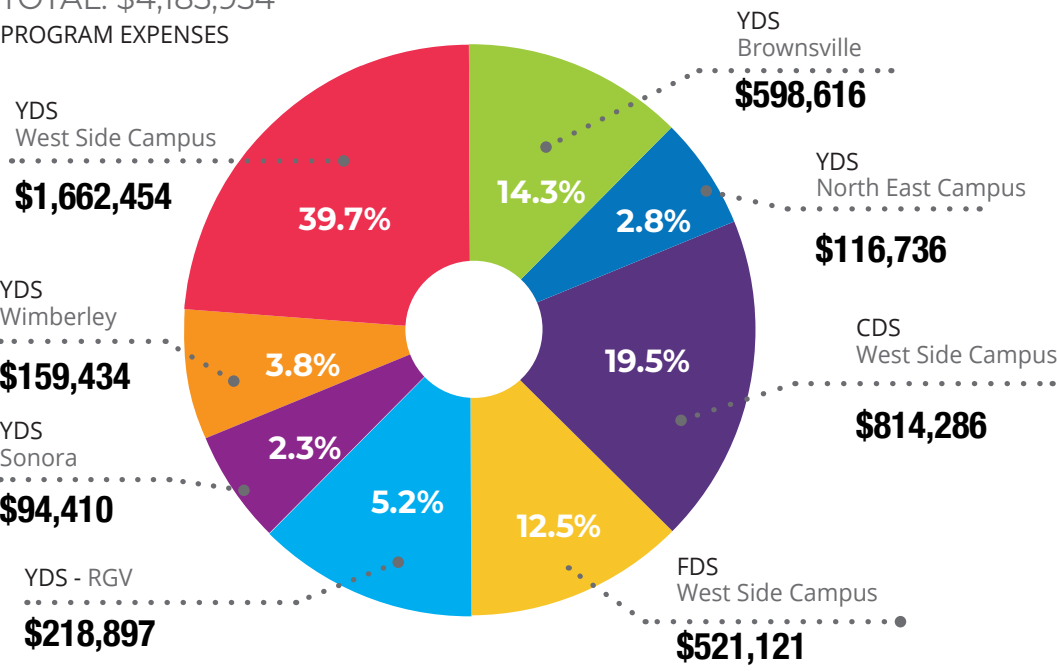

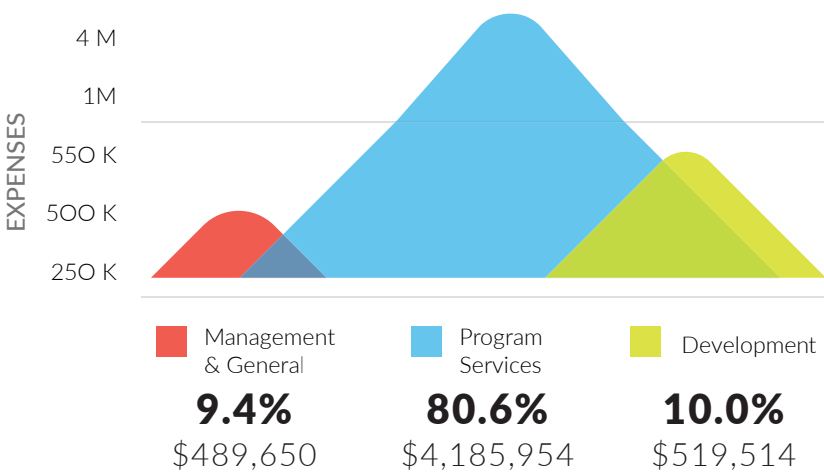
EXPENSES BY PROGRAM
